Our [Map Gallery](#) keeps expanding! We have recently added new maps showcasing **Arctic Sea Ice Deposits** at their annual minimum and maximum for 2023 and 2024. Additionally, we have created a **comparative map** illustrating the Arctic sea ice minimum in September for the years **2012 (the lowest on record)**, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024—offering a visual of changes over time.

We have also updated our **Arctic Definition Combined** maps with new projections. In addition to **North Polar Europe**, we've now added **North Polar Bering, North Polar Canada, and North Polar Russia**, providing broader perspectives on Arctic geography.
